Living a Life of Abundance

John 10:9-10

Opening remarks: Suppose I had the ability to guarantee each of you a life that was full of joy and happiness beyond measure. To assure each one of us of peace in our lives that would surpasses all understanding.

John 10:9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Note: Here the bible gives us the reason why Jesus came to this earth was so that you and I could have the abundant life and He teaches what we need to know about living the abundant life through his word.

I. Why should we do this?

As Christians, we realize what God has done for us and everyone else on the face of this earth.

II. We should Have a Heart to Thirst and Seek God.

This Scripture points out the fault of an empty soul and how vain it is to put your trust in the things of the world and carnal pleasures.

III. We should seek Spiritual Fullness.

When we received the "Fullness of God's blessings," we obtain the following: 1. His Wisdom & Understanding. 2. Divine Guidance. Psalms **16:11** Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

IV. Finally, a Christian's life revolves around "growing.

2Peter 3:18 But grow in grace, and *in* the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.

Closing remarks: The new life we enjoy had its birth in the death of the old nature; it is preserved and flourishes now only by the continuous use of that cross on which the old desires were crucified and by which they must still be mortified right on to the very last, when the body itself is put off and earthly temptations cease.
